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Together with research papers, this Journal supports and encourages the submission of reviews on books about management and connected scientific disciplines. Without questioning the importance of research papers, it would be easily demonstrable that books bring space (and time) to formulate arguments which is not possible in the limited space (and time) of research papers. In this Journal we want to connect with important books in the field through productive and interesting book reviews.

Therefore, we encourage proposals of book reviews for our evaluation. I will accumulate my role of Editor-in-Chief with that of Area Editor for book reviews. The books reviewed must be of recent publication and should present robust contributions to debate and knowledge. The reviews must contain a summary of the book's key arguments, along with a critical analysis of its contributions. When possible, reviewers should explain where the book could go further, what is disputed, and what remains to be explained in the field in question.

In this edition, besides two research papers (Parrish, 2019; Fernandes and Caldeira, 2019), we also publish Peixoto's (2019) review on the late Zygmunt Bauman's *Strangers at Our Door*. In previous editions we had the opportunity to publish several other book reviews that certainly make for interesting reading (see, for instance, Lopes, 2019; Gomes 2016, Valerio 2015). We will continue this policy of giving to important, recent books in management and related disciplines. Accordingly, we have a permanent call for the submission of book reviews which will be subject to our Editorial analysis regarding the possibility of being published in the Journal.
